Crosswalk on Isadore

• We would like to have a traffic counter and a flashing light at this crosswalk to keep our kids safe while walking to the gym.



Privacy Fencing



- Privacy fencing along 11th street would protect our children as they are outside and walking to the library.
- Projected cost: \$1500

Numbering of Exterior Doors

 The numbering of the exterior doors would help children and parents better know their drop off and pick up locations.







Lower Parking Lot

• Moving dirt to widen the entrance from 10th street, allowing a car to pull in as a car is pulling out will help the flow of traffic in the morning and afternoon.

Kitchen Windows

 Our kitchen windows don't allow for much privacy. Based on design, they would allow possible break in access.



Gym Back Doors

The back doors in the gym do not latch shut and are a danger if a child falls into them as the door would open and the child could fall.






Interior Doors for School & ECC

 Many rooms in our ECC are missing doors.
School doors do not provide the desired security.

Projected cost:\$2550/each



Extra Security Doors

• Adding a second level of security to the main school entrance (door control added to pictured doors) would provide additional safety and security for our children and staff.



Pedestrian Crossing

There is no crosswalk or flashing light to help with crossing 10th street to our Parking lot at 10th & Robidoux. We would like to add a pedestrian crosswalk and a flashing light.



New Emergency Evacuation Site

Our new emergency evacuation site for a fire in the school or ECC is the gym. As in a previous slide, a flashing light at this crosswalk would further enhance their safety.



ECC Basement

The ECC basement is in desperate need of being cleaned out. This is the evacuation location for the ECC children in the case of a tornado.
