This weekend, the entire Church is called to celebrate **Divine Mercy Sunday**. The devotion to Jesus as “the Divine Mercy” is based on the writings of St. Faustina, an uneducated Polish nun who wrote a diary of about 600 pages recording the revelations she received about God’s mercy. This day was chosen by Christ as a day of extraordinary graces – a complete outpouring of His mercy upon all who approach Him with great trust and expectant faith. On **May 5, 2000**, (five days after the canonization of **St. Faustina**), **Pope John Paul II** decreed that the Second Sunday of Easter would be known as **Divine Mercy Sunday**. 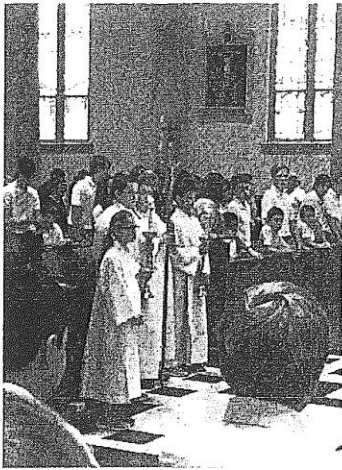
